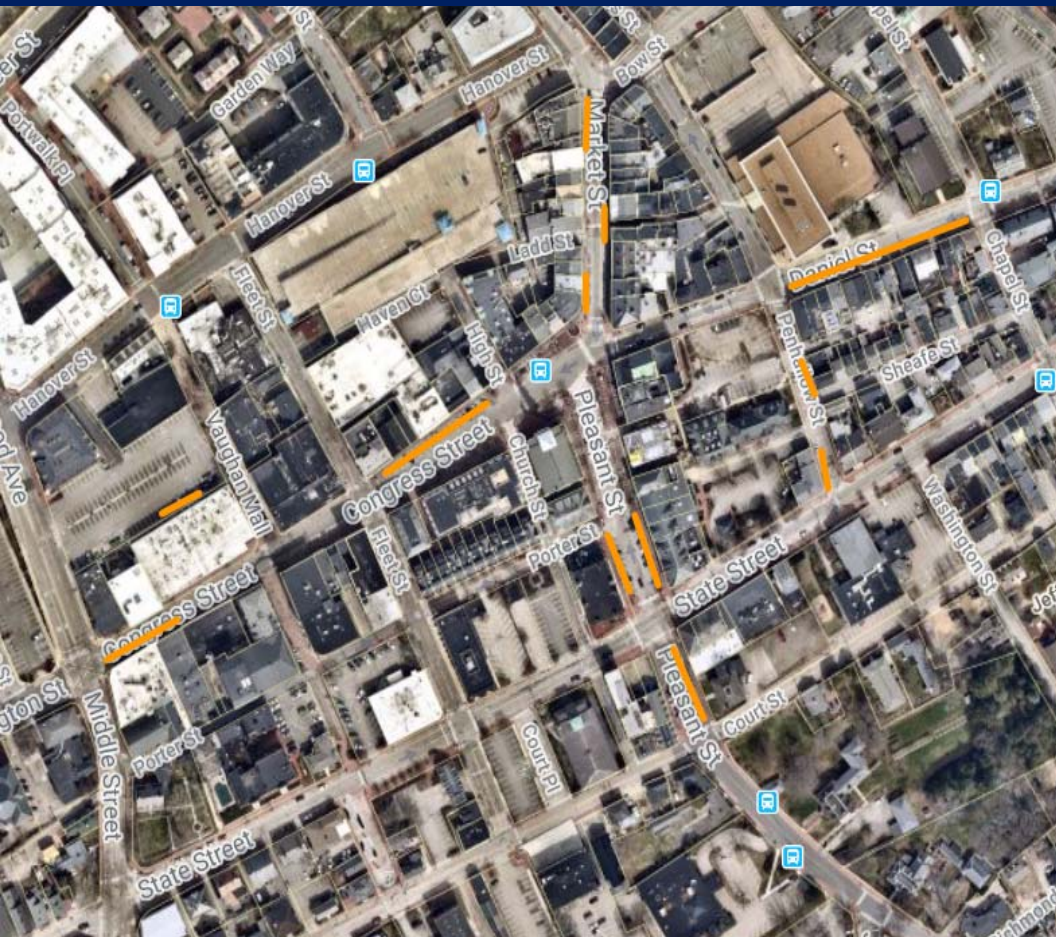

1. The Hammer – 49 Pleasant St.

Originally approved for use of loading zone on State Street and two parking spaces on Pleasant Street. Revised request proposes use of loading zone plus one parking space on State Street.

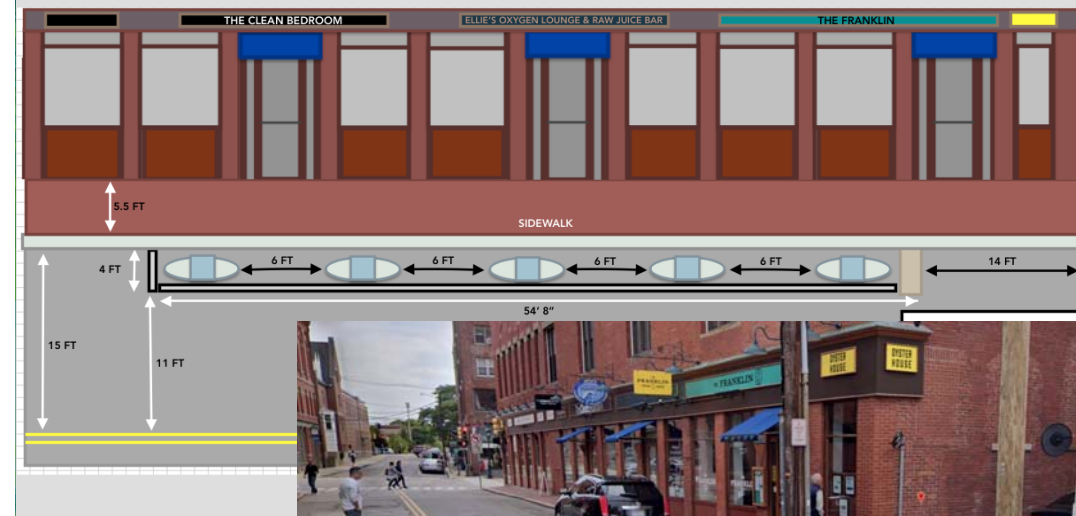
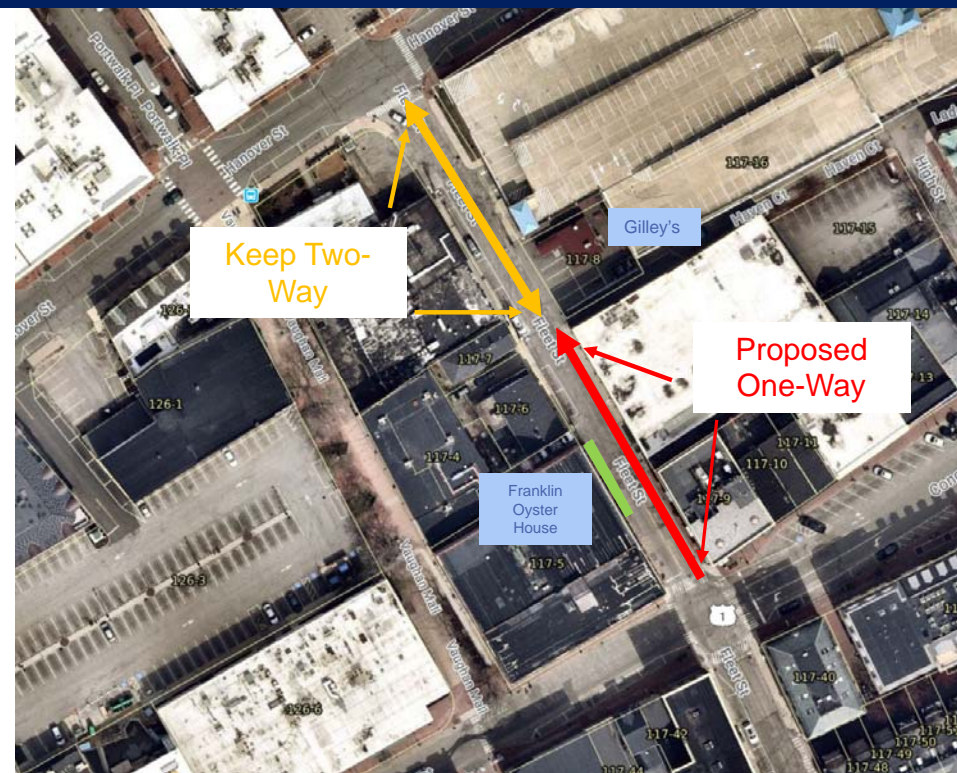


RECOMMEND APPROVAL IS CONTINGENT ON:

- Use of loading zone and one parking space on State Street;
- Vehicular access to driveway to be maintained at all times;
- Staff approval of tables/seating diagram.



2. Franklin Oyster House – Fleet St.

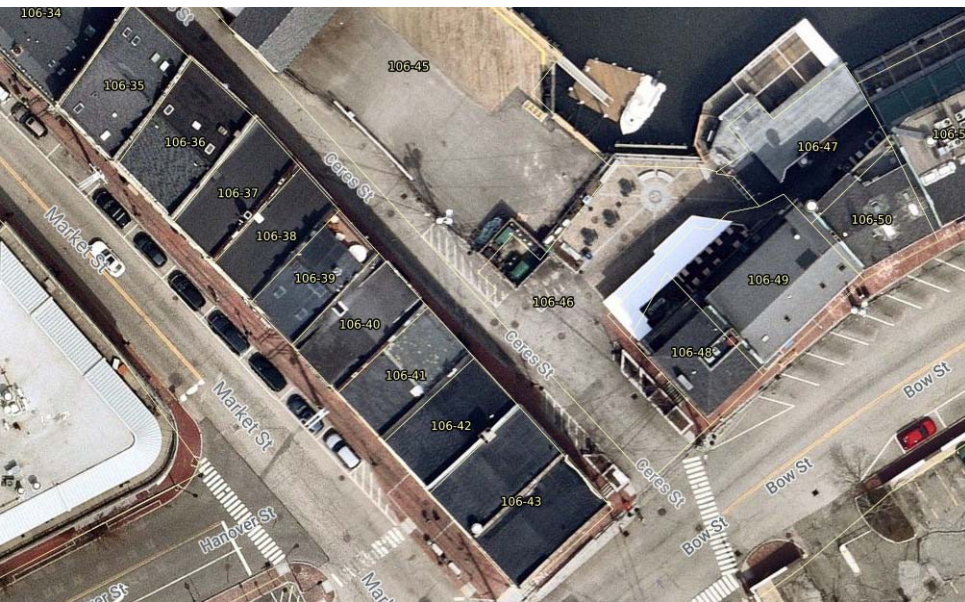


RECOMMEND APPROVAL IS CONTINGENT ON:

- Conversion of Fleet Street to one-way traffic only from Congress Street to edge of Gilley's parking lot;
- Approval from abutting property owners for use of street frontage;
- Staff approval of tables/seating diagram.

3. Black Trumpet – Ceres St.

Proposal to use sidewalk for outdoor dining (with neighbors' permission) with 18" to 2' area fenced off in the street next to curb to allow for social distancing. Street would remain open to two-way traffic. Fencing would be easily movable if required to allow for truck traffic maneuvering.



RECOMMEND APPROVAL IS CONTINGENT ON:

- Use of sidewalk-only for café seating with neighbor's permission;
- Signage to be added at either end of Ceres Street to alert motor vehicle traffic of pedestrians in roadway;
- Staff approval of tables/seating diagram.







4. Congress Street – request for parking

Bennett's Sandwich Shop has asked for 15-minute diagonal parking space(s) to be added in front of their location. Currently these are two HP spaces (one temporarily relocated from High Street end). The remainder of parking has been shifted to parallel spaces along the edge of the outdoor dining area.
