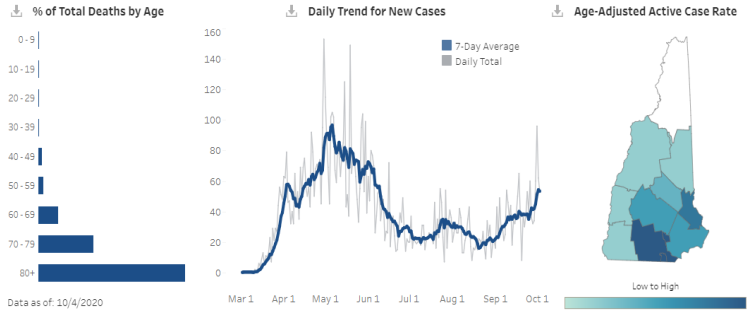


COVID-19 DASHBOARD 10/5/20

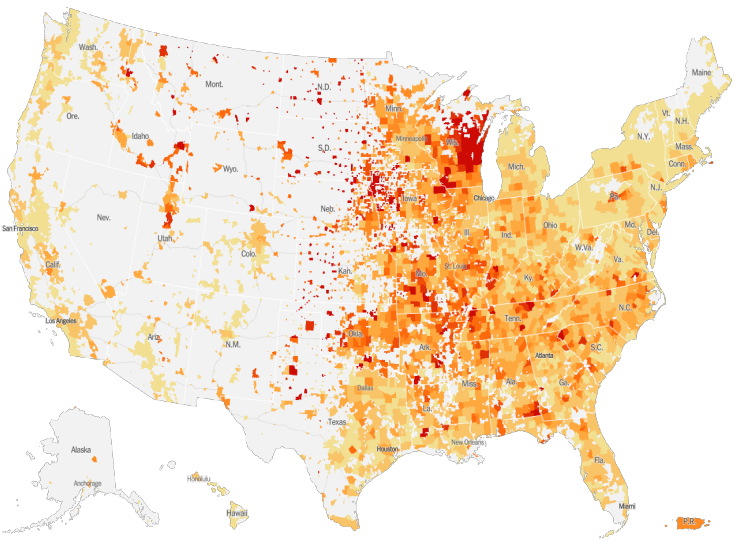

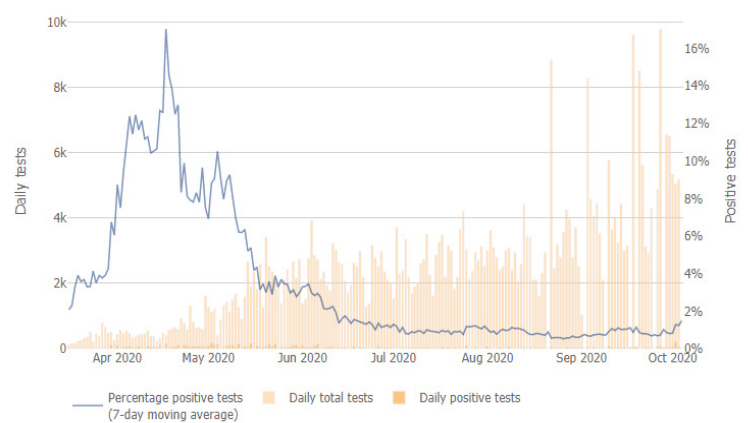
