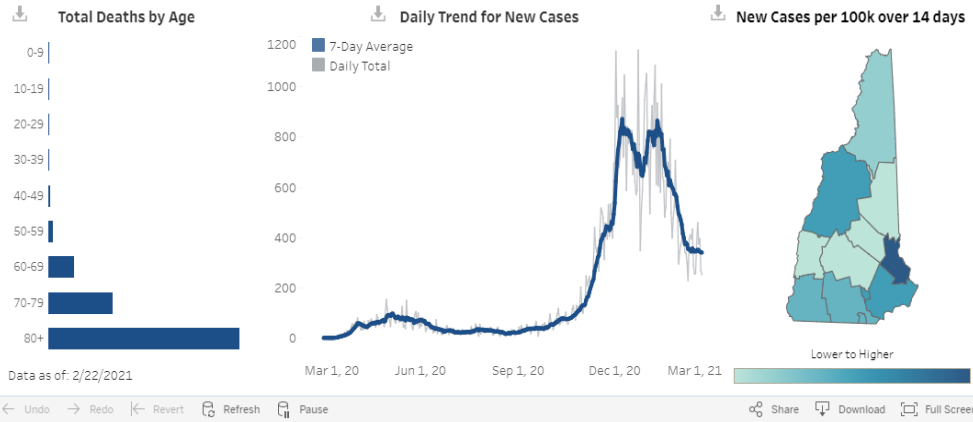

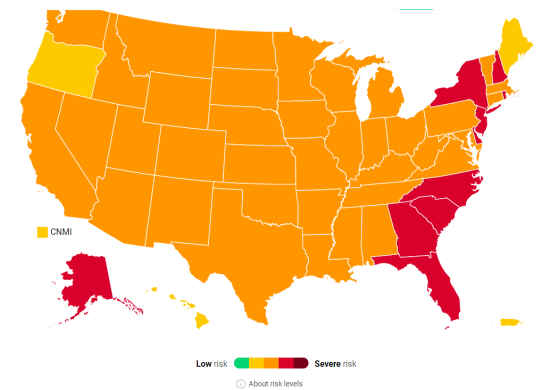
New Hampshire announced **252 cases** for February 22. There were an average of **339 cases per day** over the most recent 7-day period (February 16 to February 22). This is a **1% decrease** compared to the previous 7-day period.
