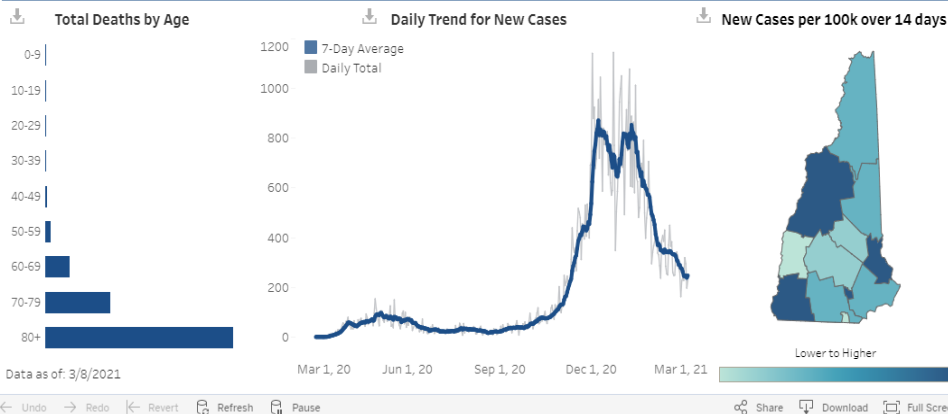

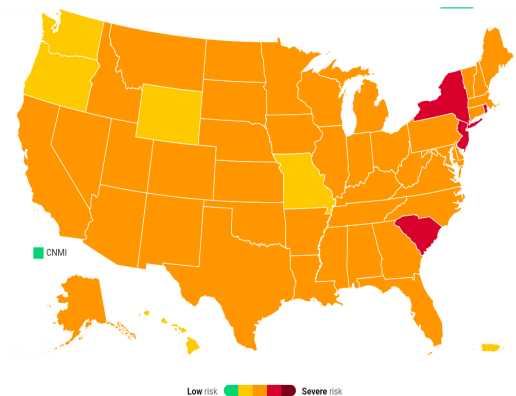
New Hampshire announced **226 cases** for March 8. There were an average of **246 cases per day** over the most recent 7-day period (March 2 to March 8). This is a **11% decrease** compared to the previous 7-day period.
