As in 2012, the proposed 2022 Study will Focus on:


- Assessment and Identification of Current and Alternative Approaches to Ensuring an Adequate Parking Supply
- Inform Future Investments & Guide Policy Choices and Zoning that:
 - Optimizes Utilization of Public Parking Facilities and Pricing
 - Cultivates Mode Shifts; Mitigates Parking Demand
 - Makes Effective Use of Available and Future Technology



HOW WILL THIS INFORM REGULATORY UPDATES

- Include a Benchmark Study to Review the Regulations of Comparable Communities to Identify Best Practices
- Explore Anticipated Parking Demand that Will Result from Approved, but Not Yet Built, Development Projects
- Explore Parking Utilization Data to Target Pricing Strategies that Will Impact Utilization Patterns
- Identify Strategies the City Should be Considering to Mitigate Parking Demand and Cultivate Mode Shifts
