WHAT IS A MUNICIPAL ELECTION?

Biennially, on the odd numbered years, the City of Portsmouth holds a Municipal Election to elect its governing bodies such as:

City Council | School Board

Fire Commission | Police Commission

Board of Registrars

Ward Officials

CANDIDACY REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a registered voter in the City of Portsmouth
- **&** A resident for 2 years, preceding the last Municipal Election
- Filing fee of \$5.00 for City Council, Fire Commission, Police Commission and School Board
- Filing fee of \$1.00 for Ward Officials
- **(a)** If a candidate does not wish to pay \$5.00, a petition with signatures of 50 qualified registered voters (*which would need to be verified*) may be submitted.
- Sign the Declaration of Candidacy
- 훩 Sign Candidates Ethics Statement

ALL CANDIDACY FILINGS MUST BE COMPLETED
IN PERSON AT THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK
WITH THE EXCEPTION OF WARD OFFICIALS

ELECTION INFORMATION

The City Council is elected AT-LARGE.

Whereas the candidate receiving the highest number of votes will be elected as

Mayor of Portsmouth.

The candidate receiving the second highest number of votes will be elected as

Assistant Mayor of Portsmouth.

Followed by
7 Councilors

FILING PERIOD WILL RUN FROM AUGUST 28, 2023—SEPTEMBER 12, 2023

On Tuesday, September 12, 2023, the Office of the City Clerk will remain open until 5:00pm to accept filings of candidates wishing to run for office.

MANDATORY FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE

STATEMENT

Who must complete a Mandatory Financial Disclosure Statement? City Council, School Board, Police and Fire Commission candidates and Political Action Committees (PAC).

How many forms must be completed?

One, seven days prior to election day with a final report, no later than two weeks following the election.

What is the amount required to be reported?

An cumulative total of \$100.00 or more.

The City Clerk will provide forms for completion by all persons and Political Action Committees.

All election financial disclosures shall be public record.
