TIME: 6:30 PM

- ♦ 18 YEARS OF AGE OR WILL BE 18 PRIOR TO ELECTION DATE
- ♦ PHOTO IDENTIFICATION
- ♦ A BIRTH CERTIFICATE OR A U.S. PASSPORT, OR U.S. MILITARY IDENTIFICATION
- MUST BE A U.S. CITIZEN/NATURALIZED CITIZEN IF NOT BORN IN U.S. WILL NEED TO SHOW U.S. PASSPORT AND/OR NATURALIZATION DOCUMENTATION.
- PROOF OF RESIDENCY (PORTSMOUTH PHYSICAL ADDRESS)
