Policing Issues

 - Traffic enforcement
 - Property or person crimes
 - Drugs
 - Other issues?
- Do you feel safe in your neighborhood? Why or why not?



Community Presence and Proactivity

- Do you feel that there is sufficient police presence in the community?
- How are officers engaged with you? Do officers stop and talk to you?
- Suggestions for the PPD to be more engaged?



Responsiveness

- When concerns over crime, traffic, and quality of life issues are brought up by the community, is PPD responsive in addressing them?
- Do you believe that there is a partnership between the PPD and the community?
- If you were to report an emergency, would you expect PPD to respond in under 10 minutes?
- If you requested PPD for a non-emergency report or event, would you
 expect an officer to respond in under 30 minutes?
- Suggestions for working more closely with the community?



Facility Needs

- Have you been to the police facility? Impressions on:
 - → The quality of the space
 - → The amount of space
 - Its location
- Should future police facilities be downtown?
- Any other suggestions on facilities?



Other Police Department Services

- Have you had experience with the PPD relating to its other services?
 - Investigations
 - Dispatch
 - Animal Control
 - → Records
- Have they met your expectations on responsiveness and service?
- What thoughts do you have to improve these services in the PPD?
